A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO A CLIMATE ADAPTATION AND RESILIENCE IMPLEMENTATION PLAN.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that as an island state,
- 2 Hawaii is uniquely prone to the impacts of climate change.
- 3 Hawaii is experiencing increased hurricane and tropical cyclone
- 4 activity, rising temperatures, hazardous inland flooding and
- 5 landslides, coastal erosion and sea level rise, drought, and
- 6 increased wildfires.
- 7 The legislature further finds that many specific plans
- 8 related to the State's climate adaptation have been published,
- 9 including the coral bleaching recovery plan, Hawaii sea level
- 10 rise vulnerability and adaptation report, multi-hazard
- 11 mitigation plan, Hawaii highways climate adaptation action plan,
- 12 and Hawaii 2050 sustainability plan. However, there is no
- 13 statewide climate adaptation and resilience implementation plan
- 14 assessing the overall financial risk of the State associated
- 15 with climate change.

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1	The purpose of this Act is to require the office of		
2	planning and sustainable development to develop and publish a		
3	Hawaii climate adaptation and resilience implementation plan and		
4	updates to the plan every five years thereafter.		
5	SECTION 2. Chapter 226, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is		
6	amended by adding a new section to part II to be appropriately		
7	designated and to read as follows:		
8	"§226- Hawaii climate adaptation and resilience		
9	implementation plan. (a) The office shall publish a Hawaii		
10	climate adaptation and resilience implementation plan that		
11	aligns with the Hawaii State Planning Act, state functional and		
12	county general plans, Hawaii 2050 sustainability plan, county		
13	climate and sustainability plans, the Hawaii climate change		
14	mitigation and adaptation initiative, the State's multiple		
15	sustainability and climate targets, and the most accurate		
16	climate data available.		
17	(b) The purpose of the Hawaii climate adaptation and		
18	resilience implementation plan shall be to:		
19	(1) Determine the overall financial risk to the State		
20	associated with climate change;

10	(C)	The Hawaii climate adaptation and resilience	
11	implementa	ation plan shall incorporate the recommendations of the	
12	Hawaii 20	50 sustainability plan pursuant to section 226-65; the	
13	Hawaii sea	a level rise vulnerability and adaptation report	
14	pursuant t	to section 225P-3; the multi-hazard mitigation plan;	
15	the State's reports coordinating sea level adaptation activitie		
16	pursuant to section 225M-9; the Hawaii drought plan; the Hawaii		
17	water plar	n; statewide community-based wildfire protection plans;	
18	county ger	neral plans; and county climate and sustainability	
19	plans, as needed.		
20	(d)	The office shall submit the Hawaii climate adaptation	
21	and resili	tence implementation plan to the legislature no later	

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- 1 than twenty days prior to the convening of the regular session
- 2 of 2027 and shall submit updates of the Hawaii climate
- 3 adaptation and resilience implementation plan every five years
- 4 thereafter."
- 5 SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general
- 6 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
- 7 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2025-2026 and
- 8 the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
- 9 year 2026-2027 to fund two full-time equivalent (2.0 FTE)
- 10 planner V positions; one full-time equivalent (1.0 FTE) planner
- 11 IV position; and computers, publication costs, website and
- 12 multimedia public outreach, management and service fees, and
- 13 other expenses necessary for the office of planning and
- 14 sustainable development to develop and publish a Hawaii climate
- 15 adaptation and resilience implementation plan pursuant to this
- 16 Act.
- 17 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the office of
- 18 planning and sustainable development for the purposes of this
- 19 Act.
- SECTION 4. New statutory material is underscored.
- 21 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2025.
