A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE HAWAII EMPLOYER-UNION HEALTH BENEFITS TRUST FUND BOARD OF TRUSTEES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Section 87A-5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is				
2	amended to read as follows:				
3	"§87	A-5 Composition of board. The board of trustees of			
4	the employer-union health benefits trust fund shall consist of				
5	[ten] nine trustees as follows:				
6	(1)	The director of finance or designee of the State, who			
7		shall be an ex officio trustee; and			
8	(2)	The following eight trustees to be appointed by the			
9		governor in accordance with the following procedure:			
10	[-(1)-	Five trustees, [A] Three trustees to represent			
11		employee-beneficiaries, one of whom shall represent			
12	•	retirees, [to represent employee-beneficiaries] and to			
13		be selected [as follows:			
14		(A) Three trustees shall be appointed from a list of			
15		two nominees per trustee selected by each of the			
16		three exclusive representative organizations that			

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1			have the largest number of
2			employee-beneficiaries;
3		(B)	One trustee shall be appointed] from a list of
4			two nominees [selected by mutual agreement of the
5			remaining] per trustee vacancy that are nominated
6			and mutually agreed to by all exclusive employee
7			representative organizations; [and
8		(C)	One trustee representing retirees shall be
9			appointed from a list of two nominees selected by
10			mutual agreement of all eligible exclusive
11			representatives; and
12	(2)	Five	[] (B) Two trustees to represent public
13		empl	oyers[-]; and
14		<u>(C)</u>	Three trustees who are residents of the State,
15			one of whom shall have at least two years of
16			experience providing financial services,
17			including investments, to public, corporate, or
18			private institutional clients, and another who
19			shall have at least two years of experience in
20			the health industry.

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1 Section 26-34 shall not apply to board member selection and 2 terms. Notwithstanding any other provision of this section, no 3 exclusive representative of a bargaining unit that sponsors or participates in a voluntary employee beneficiary association 4 shall be eligible to select nominees or to be represented by a 5 trustee on the board. 6 7 As used in this section, the term "exclusive 8 representative" shall have the same meaning as in section 89-2." SECTION 2. Section 87A-6, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 9 amended to read as follows: **10** "§87A-6 Term of a trustee; vacancy. The term of office of 11 12 each trustee shall be four years; provided that a trustee may be 13 reappointed for one additional consecutive four-year term. A vacancy on the board shall be filled in the same manner 14 15 as the trustee who vacated that position was nominated or appointed; provided that the criteria used for nominating or 16 17 appointing the successor shall be the same criteria used for nominating or appointing the person's predecessor[; provided 18 19 further that vacancies on the board for each trustee position 20 representing retirees and employee-beneficiaries appointed under

1	section 8	7A-5(1)(A) and (B) shall be filled by appointment of
2	the gover	nor as follows:
3	(1)	If a vacancy occurs in one of the trustee positions
4		described in section 87A-5(1)(A), then the vacancy
5		shall be appointed from a list of two nominees
6		submitted by the exclusive employee representative
7		from among the three largest exclusive employee
8		representatives that does not have a trustee among the
9		three trustee positions;
10	(2)	If a vacancy occurs in a trustee position described in
11		section 87A-5(1)(B), then the vacancy shall be
12		appointed from a list of two nominees submitted by
13		mutual agreement of the exclusive employee
14		representatives described in section 87A-5(1)(B); and
15	(3)	If a vacancy occurs in the retiree position described
16		in section 87A-5(1)(C), then the vacancy shall be
17		appointed from a list of two nominees submitted by
18		mutual agreement of all eligible exclusive employee
19		representatives.], or as provided under this chapter,
20		as applicable.

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         If by the end of a trustee's term the trustee is not
    reappointed or the trustee's successor is not appointed, the
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    trustee shall serve until the trustee's successor is
    appointed[-] or one hundred twenty calendar days after the
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    trustee's term ends, whichever is earlier."
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         SECTION 3. Section 87A-11, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
    amended to read as follows:
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         "[+] §87A-11[+] Quorum; board actions; voting. (a) [\frac{\text{Six}}{\text{Six}}]
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    Five trustees, [three] two of whom represent the public employer
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    and three of whom represent employee-beneficiaries, shall
    constitute a quorum for the transaction of business.
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         (b)
              [Trustees representing the public employers shall
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    collectively have one vote. Trustees representing the
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    employee-beneficiaries shall collectively have one vote.
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         For any vote of the trustees representing the public
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    employers to be valid, three of these trustees must concur to
    cast such a vote. In the absence of such concurrence, the
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    trustees representing the public employers shall be deemed to
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    have abstained from voting.
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         For any vote of the trustees representing the
    employee-beneficiaries to be valid, three of these trustees must
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- 1 concur to cast such a vote. In the absence of such concurrence,
- 2 the trustees representing the employee-beneficiaries shall be
- 3 deemed to have abstained from voting. [Each trustee shall be
- 4 entitled to one vote.
- 5 An abstention shall not be counted as either a vote in
- 6 favor or against a matter before the board.
- 7 (c) Any action taken by the board shall be by the
- 8 concurrence of at least two votes. In the event of a tie vote
- 9 on any motion, the motion shall fail. Upon the concurrence of
- 10 [six] five trustees, the board shall participate in dispute
- 11 resolution.
- 12 (d) Subject to the limitations of this part, the board,
- 13 from time to time, shall establish rules for the administration
- 14 of the funds of the system and for the transaction of its
- 15 business."
- 16 SECTION 4. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 17 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 18 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
