

A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENTS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that SpaceX is seeking 2 approval from the Federal Aviation Administration to land 3 experimental rockets over and in waters surrounding Hawaii. No 4 environmental impact statement has been conducted for these specific types of rockets, called Starships, nor has the impact 5 on Hawaiian marine life, wildlife, fishing, and cultural 6 resources been assessed. The aircraft may break into pieces of 7 8 debris upon reentry into the atmosphere or may explode in the 9 ocean. 10 In 2014, an environmental impact statement was conducted by 11 the Federal Aviation Administration, which was related to the 12 operation of a spaceport in Boca Chica, Texas, to launch a 13 Falcon 9 rocket. Numerous unforeseen SpaceX malfunctions and 14 accidents in Boca Chica have had a negative impact on the 15 surrounding natural and human environment. As a consequence, 16 environmental organizations are suing the Federal Aviation

Administration over considering only best-case scenarios in the

- 2 of scenarios.
- 3 In 2022, a less comprehensive, preliminary environmental
- 4 assessment was conducted that assessed launches and landings of
- 5 Starships sixty-two nautical miles north of Kauai and west of
- 6 the Papahanaumokuakea national marine monument, with a debris
- 7 field if it broke up upon reentry southwest of Kauai. The
- 8 biological opinion conducted by the National Oceanic and
- 9 Atmospheric Administration and the United States Fish and
- 10 Wildlife Service as part of the preliminary environmental
- 11 assessment did not include local consultation as would be
- 12 required by a full environmental impact statement and only
- 13 considered best-case scenarios.
- 14 In 2024, SpaceX sought approval for a landing zone over
- 15 twenty times larger than its initial request in 2022 and planned
- 16 to increase the number of Starship launches and landings from
- 17 five to twenty-five per year. Given the lack of previous
- 18 stakeholder participation, a change in spacecraft type, and the
- 19 dramatically expanded area, which is further affected by ocean
- 20 currents, it is unclear what the impact will be on Hawaii.
