A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO SPECIAL NUMBER PLATES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that January 4, 2026,
- 2 marks the fiftieth anniversary of the first successful landing
- 3 on Kahoolawe by nine courageous individuals, known as the
- 4 "Kahoolawe 9," in support of Native Hawaiian sovereignty and
- 5 self-determination, initiating an island wide movement to "Stop
- 6 the Bombing" and the United States' military use of the island
- 7 of Kahoolawe.
- 8 The legislature further finds that in 1976, the Protect
- 9 Kaho'olawe 'Ohana was formed and took legal action by filing a
- 10 federal lawsuit against the United States Navy, citing
- 11 violations of environmental laws, historic preservation, and
- 12 religious freedom, thus highlighting the cultural and ecological
- 13 significance of the island.
- 14 The legislature additionally finds that on October 22,
- 15 1990, President George H.W. Bush ordered the cessation of
- 16 bombing and target practice on Kaho'olawe, and in November 1990,
- 17 the United States Congress established the Kahoolawe island

- 1 conveyance commission to facilitate the return of Kahoolawe to
- 2 the State, leading the state legislature and Governor John
- 3 Waihee III to create the Kahoolawe island reserve under chapter
- 4 6K, Hawaii Revised Statutes.
- 5 The legislature recognizes that Kahoolawe, long scarred by
- 6 ranching and military activities, has become a profound symbol
- 7 of aloha aina, or love of the land, and environmental
- 8 resilience, representing the collective effort to heal the
- 9 island through reforestation, soil conservation, and cultural
- 10 renewal.
- 11 The legislature notes that the Protect Kaho'olawe 'Ohana,
- 12 Kaho'olawe island reserve commission, and department of land and
- 13 natural resources have undertaken the stewardship of the island,
- 14 restoring vital cultural practices such as the Makahiki
- 15 ceremony, which embodies the relationship between the Hawaiian
- 16 people and the land, as well as ongoing conservation efforts to
- 17 restore Kahoolawe's natural ecosystem.
- 18 The legislature believes that the efforts over the past
- 19 fifty years to restore and steward Kahoolawe exemplify the
- 20 practice of aloha aina and the resilience of the Hawaiian
- 21 community to protect and care for their land. The legislature

- 1 further believes that the many individuals who have engaged in
- 2 stewardship of Kahoolawe have been inspired to provide
- 3 stewardship of aina on their home islands.
- 4 The purpose of this Act is to authorize the issuance of
- 5 special number plates to recognize the island of Kahoolawe.
- 6 SECTION 2. Chapter 249, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 7 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
- 8 and to read as follows:
- 9 "S249- Special number plates for the recognition of the
- 10 island of Kahoolawe authorized. (a) Notwithstanding any law to
- 11 the contrary, the director of finance shall issue to any
- 12 registered owner of a vehicle, who is a resident of the State,
- 13 upon completed application and payment of required fees, a
- 14 special number plate for the registered owner's vehicle
- 15 commemorating the island of Kahoolawe.
- 16 (b) The director of finance of the city and county of
- 17 Honolulu, in consultation with the directors of finance of the
- 18 counties of Kauai, Maui, and Hawaii; the chiefs of police of the
- 19 city and county of Honolulu, and the counties of Kauai, Maui,
- 20 and Hawaii; and the board of directors of the Kohe Mālamalama o

10		law to be on a number plate and are readily
11		identifiable and distinguishable under actual traffic

13	(c)	The special number plate design shall not:
14	(1)	Infringe or otherwise violate any trademark, trade
15		name, service mark, copyright, or other proprietary or
16		<pre>property right;</pre>
17	(2)	Represent any obscene or degrading image, idea, word,
18		or phrase;
19	(3)	Advertise or endorse a product, brand, or service that
20		is provided for sale;
21	(4)	Promote any religious belief;

1	(5)	Promote any philosophy based on prejudice or that is	
2		contrary to state civil rights laws; or	
3	(6)	Is no larger than inches wide by inches	
4		high.	
5	<u>(d)</u>	Each special number plate shall be securely fastened	
6	to the mo	tor vehicle in lieu of the uniform state number plate.	
7	(e)	The director of finance shall charge a special number	
8	plate fee	at least equal to the county's cost of providing the	
9	special n	umber plate and administrative costs, if any, plus a	
10	fundraisi	ng fee to be determined by the director of finance in	
11	consultat	ion with the board of directors of the Kohe Mālamalama	
12	o Kanaloa	Protect Kahoʻolawe Fund. The fundraising fee shall be	
13	<u>in</u> additi	on to any other state or county fees collected for a	
14	motor veh	icle registration or license plate.	
15	<u>(f)</u>	The director of finance may charge an additional	
16	fundraisi	ng fee of the same or a different amount as the	
17	fundraising fee established pursuant to subsection (e), for the		
18	renewal o	f a special number plate. If an additional fundraising	
19	fee is im	plemented pursuant to this subsection, the director of	
20	finance s	hall revoke the special number plate of the registered	

- 1 owner of a motor vehicle who fails to pay the additional
- 2 fundraising fee imposed by this subsection.
- 3 (g) The revenue generated by the fundraising fees, or a
- 4 portion of the revenue generated by the fundraising fees as
- 5 determined by the director of finance, shall be deposited in the
- 6 name of the Kohe Mālamalama o Kanaloa Protect Kahoʻolawe Fund in
- 7 a separate county budget account. The <u>director</u> of finance shall
- 8 determine the most efficient means of directing the revenue
- 9 generated by the fundraising fees to the Kohe Mālamalama o
- 10 Kanaloa Protect Kaho'olawe Fund.
- 11 (h) The director of finance may revoke all special number
- 12 plates issued pursuant to this section if the total number of
- 13 registered owners of motor vehicles that obtain the special
- 14 number plate is less than one hundred fifty within three years
- 15 of issuance of the first special number plate.
- 16 (i) Nothing in this section shall be construed to apply to
- 17 any plates issued pursuant to section 249-9.2.
- 18 (j) For the purposes of this section, unless a different
- 19 meaning appears from the context, "special number plate" means a
- 20 license plate that represents the island of Kahoolawe."

18	law to be	on the license plate and is readily identifiable and	
19	distingui	shable under actual traffic conditions."
