A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAMPAIGN CONTRIBUTIONS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Section 11-302, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by amending the definition of "immediate family" to read
3	as follows:
4	""Immediate family" means a [candidate's] spouse or
5	reciprocal beneficiary, as defined in section 572C-3, and any
6	child, parent, grandparent, brother, or sister [of the
7	candidate], and the spouses or reciprocal beneficiaries of such
8	persons."
9	SECTION 2. Section 11-355, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
10	amended to read as follows:
11	"[[]§11-355[]] Contributions by state [and] <u>or</u> county
12	contractors, state or county grantees, officers or immediate
13	family members of state or county contractors, officers or
14	immediate family members of state or county grantees;
15	prohibited. (a) It shall be unlawful for any person who enters
16	into any contract with the State, any of the counties, or any
17	department or agency thereof either for the rendition of

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personal services, the buying of property, or furnishing of any 1 2 material, supplies, or equipment to the State, any of the 3 counties, any department or agency thereof, or for selling any 4 land or building to the State, any of the counties, or any 5 department or agency thereof, if payment for the performance of 6 the contract or payment for material, supplies, equipment, land, 7 property, or building is to be made in whole or in part from 8 funds appropriated by the legislative body, at any time between 9 the execution of the contract through the completion of the 10 contract, to: 11 (1) Directly or indirectly make any contribution, or 12 promise expressly or impliedly to make any 13 contribution to any candidate committee or 14 noncandidate committee, or to any candidate or to any 15 person for any political purpose or use; or 16 Knowingly solicit any contribution from any person for (2) 17 any purpose during any period. 18 It shall be unlawful for any officer or immediate (b)

19 family member of any state or county contractor under subsection
20 (a), at any time between the execution of the contract through
21 the completion of the contract pursuant to subsection (a), to

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1	directly	or indirectly make any contribution to any candidate
2	committee	or noncandidate committee, or to any candidate or to
3	any perso	n for any political purpose or use.
4	<u>(c)</u>	It shall be unlawful for any person who receives a
5	grant or	subsidy from the State pursuant to chapter 42F, or from
6	a county	pursuant to a county charter or code, at any time
7	between t	he execution of the contract through the completion of
8	the contr	act for the grant or subsidy to:
9	(1)	Directly or indirectly make any contribution, or
10		promise expressly or impliedly to make any
11		contribution to any candidate committee or
12		noncandidate committee, or to any candidate or to any
13		person for any political purpose or use; or
14	(2)	Knowingly solicit any contribution from any person for
15		any purpose during any period.
16	<u>(d)</u>	It shall be unlawful for any officer or immediate
17	family me	mber of a state or county grantee under subsection (c),
18	at any ti	me between the execution of the contract through the
19	completio	n of the contract for the grant or subsidy pursuant to
20	subsectio	n (c), to directly or indirectly make any contribution

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1	to any candidate committee or noncandidate committee, or to any
2	candidate or to any person for any political purpose or use.
3	(e) Any candidate, candidate committee, or noncandidate
4	committee that receives a contribution made unlawful by this
5	section shall return the unlawful contribution to the
6	contributor within thirty calendar days of receipt. If any
7	unlawful contribution is not returned to the contributor within
8	thirty calendar days of receipt, the unlawful contribution shall
9	escheat to the Hawaii election campaign fund.
10	[(b)] <u>(f)</u> Except as provided in [subsection] <u>subsections</u>
11	(a), <u>(b), (c), and (d),</u> this section [does] <u>shall</u> not prohibit
12	or make unlawful the establishment or administration of, or the
13	solicitation of contributions to, any noncandidate committee by
14	any person other than the state or county contractor, the state
15	or county grantee, or the officers and immediate family members
16	of a state or county contractor or grantee, for the purpose of
17	influencing the nomination for election, or the election of any
18	person to office.
19	(g) At the time of the execution of a contract subject to
20	this section, the state or county contractor or grantee shall

21 provide to the state or county office executing the contract a

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1	list of the names of any officers and immediate adult family
2	members of the state or county contractor or grantee. For the
3	purposes of assessing compliance with this section, the state or
4	county office shall make the reported information available
5	electronically to the commission, which shall then make the
6	information available to candidate and noncandidate committees
7	on a password-protected section of the commission's website;
8	provided that the state or county office shall not be required
9	to make the reported information available for procurements of
10	less than \$100,000 for goods or services or \$250,000 for
11	construction.
12	[(c)] <u>(h)</u> For purposes of this section, "completion of the
13	contract" means that the parties to the government contract have
14	either terminated the contract [prior to] <u>before</u> completion of
15	performance or fully performed the duties and obligations under

16 the contract, no disputes relating to the performance and 17 payment remain under the contract, and all disputed claims have 18 been adjudicated and are final."

19 SECTION 3. Section 11-364, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is20 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:

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1 "(a) Any candidate, candidate committee, or noncandidate 2 committee that receives in the aggregate more than the 3 applicable contribution limit in section 11-357, 11-358, 11-359, 4 or 11-360 shall return any excess contribution to the contributor within thirty calendar days of receipt of the excess 5 6 contribution. Any candidate, candidate committee, or 7 noncandidate committee that receives in the aggregate more than 8 the applicable contribution limit in section 11-362 shall return 9 any excess contribution to the contributor within thirty 10 calendar days of the end of the election period; provided that 11 the candidate, candidate committee, or noncandidate committee 12 may choose which contributions to return. Any excess 13 contribution not returned to the contributor within thirty 14 calendar days shall escheat to the Hawaii election campaign 15 fund."

16 SECTION 4. This Act does not affect rights and duties that 17 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were 18 begun before its effective date.

19 SECTION 5. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed20 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

SECTION 6. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 3000.

CSC; State or County Contractors; State or County Grantees; Officers; Immediate Family Members; Prohibited Contributions

Description:

Prohibits state or county grantees and officers and immediate family members of state or county contractors or grantees from contributing to candidate or noncandidate committees, candidates, or any person for any political purpose for the duration of the contract. Requires any unlawful contribution to be returned to the contributor or it will escheat to the Hawaii Election Campaign Fund. Requires disclosures of the names of any officers and immediate adult family members of a state or county contractor or grantee for contracts exceeding a certain amount. Effective 7/1/3000. (SD1)
