A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO OUT-OF-STATE OFFICES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that enhancing economic
- 2 ties between Hawaii and the Republic of the Philippines (the
- 3 Philippines) presents significant opportunities for
- 4 strengthening mutual economic development. Filipinos have
- 5 emerged as the second-largest ethnic group in Hawaii,
- 6 representing approximately twenty-five per cent of Hawaii's
- 7 population, and play major roles in all sectors of Hawaii's
- 8 economy. In addition, President Ferdinand R. Marcos, Jr. has
- 9 recently emphasized the potential for expanding trade
- 10 cooperation between the Philippines and Hawaii. Assisting small
- 11 businesses in developing and marketing products, focusing on
- 12 strengthening economic development, expanding and diversifying
- 13 trade opportunities, promoting cultural exchanges, and
- 14 leveraging the Filipino community in Hawaii can enhance the
- 15 economic and cultural partnerships between Hawaii and the
- 16 Philippines and lead to sustained growth and mutual benefits.

- 1 Accordingly, the purpose of this Act is to require the
- 2 department of business, economic development, and tourism to
- 3 establish an out-of-state office in the Republic of the
- 4 Philippines.
- 5 SECTION 2. The department of business, economic
- 6 development, and tourism shall establish an out-of-state office
- 7 in the Republic of the Philippines as authorized under section
- 8 201-81, Hawaii Revised Statutes.
- 9 SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general
- 10 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
- 11 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2025-2026 and
- 12 the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
- 13 year 2026-2027 for the department of business, economic
- 14 development, and tourism to establish an out-of-state office in
- 15 the Republic of the Philippines.
- 16 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department
- 17 of business, economic development, and tourism for the purposes
- 18 of this Act.
- 19 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.
