A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO STUDENT ATHLETES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the benefits of 2 providing students with opportunities to participate in 3 athletics extend beyond improved physical fitness. Multiple 4 studies have concluded that student athletes tend to have higher 5 academic achievement compared to non-athletes and have suggested 6 that participating in sports improves discipline and time 7 management, resulting in improved grades, graduation rates, and 8 career outcomes. Studies have also shown that student athletes 9 experience better mental health outcomes including lower rates of stress, anxiety, and depression and higher levels of 10 11 emotional well-being when compared to their non-athlete peers. 12 The legislature further finds that student athletes in 13 certain counties encounter difficulties in traveling to other 14 schools to compete. For example, as a multi-island 15 jurisdiction, Maui county students participating in school 16 sports face unique and burdensome challenges when attending 17 competitions within the county, including the cost of air or sea

- 1 travel and access to reasonable lodging accommodations.
- 2 Multiple days of travel are often required for Maui county
- 3 student athletes to attend competitions on a non-home island.
- 4 This requires significant fundraising efforts and logistical
- 5 planning, which may include chartering boats or planes, renting
- 6 multiple vehicles, recruiting volunteers on a non-home island to
- 7 house, feed, and shuttle students, coaches, and chaperones,
- 8 sleeping on gym floors, and relying on unhealth but convenient
- 9 food.
- 10 The legislature notes that the travel costs for student
- 11 athletes to compete within Maui county presents a significant
- 12 and unique financial and logistical burden for both the athletes
- 13 and their families, which may affect the ability of the student
- 14 athletes to compete at their highest form. The legislature
- 15 believes that providing a funding mechanism to cover
- 16 intra-county travel expenses of certain student athletes is
- 17 essential for ensuring equitable access to the opportunities and
- 18 benefits provided through participating in school sports and
- 19 athletics.
- The purpose of this Act is to establish and appropriate
- 21 funds for a student athlete travel pilot program to provide

- 1 funds for intra-county travel expenses for student athletes of
- 2 counties with a population of less than five hundred thousand.
- 3 SECTION 2. (a) There is established a three-year student
- 4 athlete travel pilot program, to be administered by the
- 5 department of education, to provide funding for intra-county
- 6 travel expenses for student athletes of counties with a
- 7 population of less than five hundred thousand.
- 8 (b) The department of education may collaborate with
- 9 private entities and volunteers for the chartering or rental of
- 10 transportation and housing for participating students of the
- 11 pilot program.
- 12 (c) The department of education shall submit a report of
- 13 its findings and recommendations, including any proposed
- 14 legislation, on the student athlete travel pilot program to the
- 15 legislature no later than twenty days prior to the convening of
- 16 the regular session of 2028. The report shall include:
- 17 (1) The number of student athletes participating in the
- pilot program;
- 19 (2) The total amount of funds used for the pilot program
- and amount of funds used for each student athlete; and

- (3) The companies the pilot program contracted with to
 provide transportation to student athletes.
- 3 (d) The pilot program shall cease to exist on June 30,
- 4 2028.
- 5 SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general
- 7 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2025-2026 and
- 8 the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
- 9 year 2026-2027 for the establishment and implementation of the
- 10 student athlete travel pilot program pursuant to section 2 of
- 11 this Act; provided that the funds appropriated may be used for
- 12 the hiring of an athletic clerk to assist with travel
- 13 procurement and the implementation of the pilot program.
- 14 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department
- 15 of education for the purposes of this Act.
- 16 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 3000, and
- 17 shall be repealed on June 30, 2028.
