HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

URGING THE DEPARTMENT OF BUSINESS, ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT, AND TOURISM TO EVALUATE AND DEVELOP RECOMMENDATIONS FOR THE INITIATION OF A MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN HAWAII AND NEW ZEALAND TO FOSTER STRONGER TIES IN ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT, ARTS AND CULTURAL EXCHANGE, EDUCATION, AND ENVIRONMENTAL SUSTAINABILITY.

WHEREAS, Hawaii and New Zealand share deep historical, 1 cultural, economic, and environmental connections, rooted in the 2 rich heritage of the Pacific islands; and 3 4 WHEREAS, the indigenous peoples of Hawaii and New Zealand, 5 6 the Kanaka Maoli and Māori, share linguistic, ancestral, and cultural ties as members of the greater Polynesian family; and 7 8 9 WHEREAS, Hawaii and New Zealand are committed to the 10 preservation and promotion of indigenous cultures, sustainable 11 environmental practices, and economic development that respects traditional knowledge and values; and 12 13 WHEREAS, Hawaii and New Zealand serve as important hubs for 14 regional cooperation, fostering economic development and 15 16 environmental sustainability throughout the Pacific region; and 17 WHEREAS, the establishment of a memorandum of understanding 18 would strengthen mutual interests in trade, tourism, education, 19 environmental protection, cultural exchange, and disaster 20 preparedness and response efforts; and 21 22 WHEREAS, the arts are a vital and transformative part of 23 Hawaii's cultural identity and economy, and New Zealand's rich 24 artistic traditions offer an opportunity for cross-cultural 25 26 collaboration, creative exchange, and mutual growth in the arts; 27 and

1 2 WHEREAS, the establishment of a memorandum of understanding 3 would foster artistic innovation, enhance cultural understanding, and create new opportunities for artistic 4 expression, education, and professional development in both 5 Hawaii and New Zealand; and 6 7 8 WHEREAS, a formalized relationship between Hawaii and New 9 Zealand would provide opportunities for collaboration in renewable energy initiatives, agricultural innovation, marine 10 conservation, and technology sharing; and 11 12 13 WHEREAS, cultural exchange programs between educational institutions in Hawaii and New Zealand would enhance 14 understanding and appreciation of Polynesian traditions, 15 language revitalization efforts, and academic cooperation in 16 fields such as marine biology, climate change, and Pacific 17 18 studies; and 19 WHEREAS, the people of Hawaii and New Zealand share a 20 strong commitment to global peace, security, and prosperity, 21 making a memorandum of understanding an opportunity to promote 22 goodwill and shared goals; now, therefore, 23 24 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the 25 Thirty-third Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session 26 of 2025, the Senate concurring, that the Department of Business, 27 Economic Development, and Tourism is urged to evaluate and 28 develop recommendations for the initiation of a memorandum of 29 understanding between Hawaii and New Zealand to foster stronger 30 ties in economic development, arts and cultural exchange, 31 education, and environmental sustainability; and 32 33 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Governor is urged, in 34 consultation with relevant government agencies and stakeholders, 35 to take necessary steps to implement this memorandum of 36 understanding and facilitate ongoing collaboration; and 37 38 39 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that upon the establishment of the memorandum of understanding, appropriate state agencies, 40

educational institutions, business organizations, and cultural

institutions are encouraged to develop programs and initiatives in collaboration with their counterparts in New Zealand; and BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Governor; Director of Business, Economic Development, and Tourism; and Prime Minister of New Zealand.
