## HOUSE RESOLUTION

RELATING TO THE SALARIES OF CERTAIN STATE OFFICIALS.

1 WHEREAS, Article XVI Section 3.5, The Constitution of the State of Hawaii ("Constitution") creates a Salary Commission 2 ("Commission") to review and recommend salaries for the governor, 3 the lieutenant governor, department heads of the executive 4 5 departments, members of the legislature, justices and judges of all state courts; and 6 7 WHEREAS, under the Constitution, the Commission is required 8 to make a decision by the fortieth legislative day of the 2007 9 10 regular session and every six years thereafter and shall submit its recommendations to the legislature; and 11 12 WHEREAS, since 2006, the Commission has met, and submitted 13 14 recommendations to the legislature in 2007, 2013, and 2019 15 respectively; and 16 WHEREAS, Section 26-56, Hawaii Revised Statutes, as amended 17 provides further quidance on the recommendations of the 18 Commission; and 19 20 21 WHEREAS, the salaries recommended by the Commission shall become effective on July 1 of the next fiscal year unless 22 disapproved by the legislature by adoption of a concurrent 23 resolution approved by a simple majority in each house of the 24 25 legislature prior to adjournment sine die of the legislative session in which the recommended salaries are submitted; and 26 27 WHEREAS, if the Commission's recommendations are 28 29 disapproved by the legislature, the commission shall reconvene 30 in November next following the legislature's disapproval to review the reasons for disapproving its salary recommendations; 31 32 and 33

WHEREAS, the Commission, if reconvened after a disapproval 1 2 of their recommendations, may submit a report of its findings 3 and submit a new salary recommendation to the legislature at the 4 next regular session; and 5 WHEREAS, the Commission's reconvening following a 6 7 legislative disapproval shall not toll the six-year cycle; and 8 WHEREAS, the 2025 Commission on Salaries issued its Report 9 and Recommendations to the 2025 Legislature on March 4, 2025 to 10 increase the salaries and adjust the salary schedules for 11 certain State officials; and 12 13 14 WHEREAS, the State Legislature wishes to express its appreciation for the work of the 2025 Commission on Salaries, 15 but concludes that the salary increases and salary adjustments 16 17 recommended by the 2025 Commission on Salaries are excessive in 18 light of current economic conditions in the State of Hawaii and 19 should be rejected; now, therefore, 20 21 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the Thirty-third Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session 22 of 2025, by a simple majority of its entire membership, 23 24 disapproves the recommendation of the 2025 Commission on Salaries and the salary and salary schedule increases 25 26 recommended therein; and 27 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Commission shall reconvene 28 29 no later than November 2025 to review the reasons for the 30 legislatures disapproval, submit a report of its findings, and submit a new salary recommendation to the legislature in the 31 32 2026 legislative session; and 33 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this 34 Resolution be transmitted to the Office of the Governor, the 35 36 Office of the Lieutenant Governor, the Chief Justice of the 37 Judiciary, The Senate President, The Speaker of the House, and the Chair of the 2025 Commission on Salaries. 38 39 40 41
