A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO NURSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. (a) The department of health shall establish a
- 2 five-year nurse recertification pilot program to facilitate the
- 3 timely recertification of, or the issuance of temporary licenses
- 4 to, nurses who wish to rejoin the workforce but whose previous
- 5 certifications have lapsed.
- 6 (b) The department shall submit interim reports to the
- 7 legislature on the status of the pilot program no later than
- 8 twenty days prior to the convening of the regular sessions of
- 9 2026, 2027, 2028, and 2029, and a final report of its findings
- 10 and recommendations, including any proposed legislation, no
- 11 later than twenty days prior to the convening of the regular
- 12 session of 2030.
- 13 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 14 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much
- 15 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2025-2026 and the
- 16 same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year

- 1 2026-2027 for the establishment and implementation of a nurse
- 2 recertification pilot program.
- 3 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department
- 4 of health for the purposes of this Act.
- 5 SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general
- 6 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$100,000 or so much
- 7 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2025-2026 and the
- 8 same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year
- 9 2026-2027 for the department of health to award scholarships to
- 10 eligible nursing students who agree to teach nursing in Hawaii
- 11 after graduating.
- 12 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department
- 13 of health for the purposes of this Act.
- 14 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2025.
