A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO TEACHER WORKFORCE HOUSING.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION	ON 1. Chapter 302A, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by	adding a new section to part III, subpart E, to be
3	appropriate	ely designated and to read as follows:
4	" <u>§302</u>	A- Teacher workforce housing; stipend program;
5	rural and	underserved schools. (a) There is established a
6	teacher wo	rkforce housing stipend program to be administered by
7	the depart	ment to support teacher retention at any public school
8	designated	as rural or in an underserved area.
9	(b)	An individual shall be eligible for stipend
10	considerat	ion if the individual:
11	(1)	Is employed full-time by the department in a public or
12	:	charter school in an area designated as rural or
13		underserved; and
14	(2)	Does not own a residence within commuting distance
15		from the school at which they are employed.
16	<u>(c)</u>	Stipend recipients shall receive \$1,000 per month;
17	provided t	hat stipends awarded shall only be used only for rent,

- 1 mortgage payments, or utilities. Recipients of the teacher
- 2 workforce housing stipend shall submit annual documentation
- 3 verifying the usage of the stipend for housing purposes pursuant
- 4 to this subsection.
- 5 (d) Immediately following an award of a stipend, the
- 6 recipient shall commit to teaching at a school in an area
- 7 designated as rural or underserved for a minimum of three years.
- 8 A stipend recipient may continue to receive a stipend pursuant
- 9 to this section following the completion of the designated
- 10 number of years; provided that the recipient continues to meet
- 11 eligibility requirements pursuant to subsection (b).
- (e) If the recipient fails to satisfy the work
- 13 requirements in accordance with subsection (d), the recipient
- 14 shall repay the total amount of the stipend funds received as a
- 15 loan repayable to the department. The repayment shall be
- 16 subject to the terms and conditions set by the department.
- 17 (f) The department shall submit a report of its findings
- 18 and recommendations, including any proposed legislation, to the
- 19 legislature no later than twenty days prior to the convening of
- 20 the regular session for every odd-numbered year, beginning with
- 21 the regular session of 2027."

1	SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
2	revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
3	much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2025-2026 and
4	the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
5	year 2026-2027 for the establishment and administration of the
6	teacher workforce housing stipend program established pursuant
7	to section 1 of this Act.
8	The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department
9	of education for the purposes of this Act.
10	SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.
11	SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2025.
