# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO EDUCATION.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that teachers understand 2 their students' needs and tailor their classrooms to create an 3 engaging and effective learning experience. Nationwide, 4 teachers spend an average of \$500 out-of-pocket on their 5 classrooms each year. To alleviate the financial burden on 6 teachers, the department of education is committed to providing 7 funding for teacher-requested classroom supplies. The 8 legislature further finds that the department of education 9 intends to engage in public-private partnerships focused on leveraging existing financial resources from both sectors to 10 11 provide teachers and students with project-based resources. 12 Accordingly, the purpose of this Act is to appropriate

13 funds to the department of education for teacher-requested 14 classroom supplies.

15 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general 16 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so 17 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2025-2026 and

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1 the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal 2 year 2026-2027 to provide funding for teacher-requested 3 classroom supplies; provided that no state funds shall be 4 expended unless the private sector contributes matching private 5 funds on a dollar-for-dollar basis. 6 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department 7 of education for the purposes of this Act.

8 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 3000.
