RELATING TO LEGISLATORS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Chapter 84, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended
2	by adding a new section to part II to be appropriately
3	designated and to read as follows:
4	" <u>§84-</u> Legislators; state equipment; community
5	initiatives. (a) Notwithstanding any other provision of this
6	chapter or any other law to the contrary, but subject to
7	subsections (b) and (c), a legislator may use state-owned or
8	state-operated equipment, including vehicles, computers, and
9	machines, for any bona fide community initiative; provided that
10	the legislator is trained, qualified, or licensed to use the
11	state-owned or state-operated equipment, if the training,
12	qualification, or licensure is otherwise required by law, rule,
13	or lease contract requirements.
14	(b) Any legislator who purports to use state-owned or
15	state-operated equipment for a bona fide community initiative
16	pursuant to subsection (a), but who actually uses the equipment

1	for any other purpose, shall be subject to this chapter, to the
2	extent_applicable.
3	(c) For the purposes of this section:
4	"Bona fide community initiative" means any activity that:
5	(1) Is conducted within the electoral district represented
6	by the legislator;
7	(2) Responds to community needs, promotes civic
8	engagement, or fosters stronger connections among
9	community members; and
10	(3) Is conducted by an entity that is not:
11	(A) A for-profit business entity;
12	(B) Managed or controlled by the legislator; or
13	(C) An employer of the legislator.
14	"Legislator" means any state senator or state
15	representative who uses or attempts to use state-owned or
16	state-operated equipment pursuant to this section."
17	SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
18	matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
19	begun before its effective date.
