A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO PUBLIC EMPLOYMENT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that a significant number 2 of government positions are funded but currently vacant and have 3 remained so for multiple years. The purpose of this bill is to 4 eliminate wasteful spending by requiring the abolishment of 5 public employment positions that have been vacant for six years 6 if the hiring department or agency has not certified that they 7 are awaiting approval to hire for that position. 8 SECTION 2. Section 26-5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 9 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows: 10 "(a) The department of human resources development shall 11 be headed by a single executive to be known as the director of human resources development. The director shall: 12 13 (1)Facilitate and expedite the hiring and recruitment for 14 civil service positions under the jurisdiction of the 15 department of human resources development; and
- 16 (2) Have the authority to reclassify and abolish vacant
 17 positions within state departments and agencies that

4	(A)	[Prior to] Except as provided in subparagraph			
5		(c); before reclassifying or abolishing any			
6		vacant position as provided under this paragraph,			
7		the director shall submit a report to the			
8		legislature no later than twenty days prior to			
9		each regular session[. The report shall-include			
10		a list of vacant positions for reclassification			
11		or abolishment, identify the agency each position			
12		is attached to, provide reasons for reclassifying			
13		or abolishing the position, and state the			
14		duration that the position has been vacant; and];			
15	(B)	The director may reclassify or abolish any vacant			
16		position as provided under this paragraph no			
17		earlier than sixty days after the report has been			
18		submitted to the legislature as provided under			
19		subparagraph (A) [+];			
20	<u>(C)</u>	The director shall abolish any position that has			
21		been vacant for more than five years; provided			

1		that	the time a position has been vacant shall be
2		compu	ated beginning on the date the position was
3		creat	ted or vacated by a state employee; provided
4		furth	ner that this requirement shall not apply to
5		posit	tions for which the hiring department or
6		agend	cy certifies that it is awaiting approval to
7		hire.	. Funds for positions abolished under this
8		subpa	aragraph shall immediately lapse to the
9		credi	it of the general fund; and
10	(D)	The r	report required to be submitted to the
11		legis	slature pursuant to subparagraph (A) shall
12		inclu	ide:
13		<u>(i)</u>	A list of vacant positions that will be
14			reclassified or abolished, the agency each
15			position is attached to, the duration that
16			the position has been vacant, and the
17			reasons for the reclassification or
18			abolishment; and
19	_	<u>(ii)</u>	A list of positions abolished pursuant to
20			subparagraph (C)."

- 2 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 3 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.

Report Title:

DHRD; Vacant Positions; Reclassification; Abolishment; Report; General Fund

Description:

Requires the Director of Human Resources Development to abolish vacant positions within state departments and agencies under its jurisdiction that have been vacant for more than five years. Requires a list of positions abolished to be included in the Director's annual report to the Legislature. Requires funds for abolished positions to immediately lapse to the credit of the general fund.

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
