A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO EDUCATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. Act 124, Session Laws of Hawaii 2015,
authorized the department of education to award high school
diplomas to qualified persons who did not receive a high school
diploma as a result of compulsory induction into active service
in the armed services of the United States or any person whose
high school education was interrupted due to wartime practices
such as internment during World War II until June 30, 2020.

8 The purpose of this Act is to authorize the department of 9 education to award high school diplomas to a qualified person 10 who did not receive a high school diploma as a result of 11 compulsory or voluntary induction into active service in the 12 armed services of the United States or whose high school 13 education was interrupted due to wartime practices during World 14 War II, the Korean War, or the Vietnam War.

15 SECTION 2. Chapter 302A, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 16 amended by adding a new section to part II to be appropriately 17 designated and to read as follows:
