A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO MOTOR VEHICLES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that Hawaii is cluttered
- 2 with abandoned and unregistered motor vehicles. The legislature
- 3 believes that it must take action to disincentivize the
- 4 continued possession and use of unregistered motor vehicles.
- 5 Accordingly, the purpose of this Act is to require the
- 6 department of transportation, in coordination with the counties
- 7 of the State, to establish a one-year unregistered motor vehicle
- 8 amnesty pilot program to encourage motor vehicle registration
- 9 and mandate the surrender or impoundment of unregistered motor
- 10 vehicles after the expiration of the program.
- 11 SECTION 2. (a) The department of transportation, in
- 12 coordination with the counties of the State, shall establish a
- 13 one-year unregistered motor vehicle amnesty pilot program, to
- 14 commence on
- 15 (b) Under the program, the owner of an unregistered motor
- 16 vehicle located within the State shall register the motor
- 17 vehicle within one year or surrender the vehicle to the State.



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- 1 Any motor vehicle that is not registered or surrendered by the
- 2 expiration of the pilot program shall be surrendered to or
- 3 impounded by the State.
- 4 (c) The department of transportation shall adopt emergency
- 5 rules for the purposes of the Act, pursuant to section 91-3(b),
- 6 Hawaii Revised Statutes. In justifying the adoption of these
- 7 rules, the department shall declare that the prevalence of
- 8 abandoned and unregistered vehicles in the State presents
- 9 imminent peril to the public health, safety, and morals.
- 10 (d) The department of transportation shall submit a report
- 11 of the results of the pilot program, and any proposed
- 12 legislation, to the legislature no later than twenty days prior
- 13 to the convening of the regular session of 2027.
- 14 (e) The provisions of this Act shall apply notwithstanding
- 15 any law to the contrary.
- 16 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 17 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much
- 18 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2025-2026 and the
- 19 same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year
- 20 2026-2027 for administering the one-year unregistered motor
- 21 vehicle amnesty pilot program.

- 1 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department
 2 of transportation for the purposes of this Act
- 2 of transportation for the purposes of this Act.
- 3 SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general
- 4 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of
- 5 (1) \$ to the city and county of Honolulu;
- 6 (2) \$ to the county of Hawaii;
- 7 (3) \$ to the county of Maui;
- **8** (4) \$ to the county of Kauai;
- 9 or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2025-2026
- 10 and the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for
- 11 fiscal year 2026-2027 for costs relating to the one-year
- 12 unregistered motor vehicle amnesty pilot program.
- 13 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department
- 14 of transportation for the purposes of this Act.
- 15 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
