SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

ESTABLISHING THE TASK FORCE FOR SPEED (SIMPLIFYING PERMITTING FOR ENHANCED ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT) TO IDENTIFY ACTIONS NEEDED TO EXPEDITE, FACILITATE, AND COORDINATE STATE AND INTERGOVERNMENTAL PERMIT PROCESSES.

1 WHEREAS, the permitting process can be subject to lengthy 2 waiting periods, leading to delays in housing, industrial, and 3 commercial projects and stifling economic development in the 4 State; and

6 WHEREAS, bringing together representatives from the various 7 agencies responsible for permitting can greatly enhance 8 understanding of issues present in the permitting process and 9 help determine changes needed to expedite the process; now, 10 therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Thirty-third Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2025, the House of Representatives concurring, that there is established the Task Force for SPEED (Simplifying Permitting for Enhanced Economic Development) to identify actions needed to expedite, facilitate, and coordinate state and intergovernmental permit processes; and
