SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION TO INSTALL AND UTILIZE ELECTRONIC SCANNING EQUIPMENT AT EACH STATE AIRPORT AND HARBOR TO SCAN FOR ILLEGAL FIREWORKS.

WHEREAS, the illegal importation and use of fireworks pose 1 significant threats to public safety, property, and the 2 environment in the State of Hawaii; and 3 4 WHEREAS, the presence of illegal fireworks contributes to 5 hazardous conditions, including fires, injuries, and 6 7 disturbances to residents and pets; and 8 WHEREAS, current enforcement measures have proven 9 insufficient in preventing the unlawful entry of fireworks into 10 the State; and 11 12 WHEREAS, improved screening methods at state airports and 13 harbors would serve as a proactive measure to curb the influx of 14 illegal fireworks; and 15 16 WHEREAS, modern electronic scanning equipment can detect 17 contraband materials, including many types of explosives and 18 fireworks; and 19 20 WHEREAS, implementing scanning technology at state airports 21 and harbors would enhance the ability of law enforcement and 22 regulatory agencies to intercept and prevent the distribution of 23 illegal fireworks; now, therefore, 24 25 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Thirty-third 26 Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2025, the 27 House of Representatives concurring, that the Department of 28 Transportation is requested to install and utilize electronic 29 scanning equipment at each state airport and harbor to scan for 30 illegal fireworks; and 31
