1	WHEREAS, this body finds that the duties of the Office of

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25	WHER	EAS, increasing civic engagement and understanding of
26	the legislative process empowers Native Hawaiians to advocate

1 WHEREAS, the Office of Hawaiian Affairs serves as a vital 2 institution dedicated to improving the well-being of Native Hawaiians through advocacy, research, and community support; and 3 4 5 WHEREAS, the Office of Hawaiian Affairs has the resources and capacity to facilitate educational initiatives that promote 6 greater awareness and participation in the legislative process; 7 and 8 9 10 WHEREAS, legislative engagement forums will provide valuable opportunities for Native Hawaiians to learn about bill 11 12 drafting, testimony submission, committee hearings, and other aspects of civic engagement; and 13 14 15 WHEREAS, legislative engagement forums may be conducted through in-person workshops, virtual seminars, and outreach 16 efforts in various communities across the State; now, therefore, 17 18 19 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Thirty-third Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2025, the 20 21 House of Representatives concurring, that the Office of Hawaiian Affairs is requested to establish and provide legislative 22 engagement forums to educate and empower the Native Hawaiian 23 community regarding the legislative process; and 24 25 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Office of Hawaiian Affairs 26 is encouraged to collaborate with community organizations, 27 educational institutions, and legislative bodies to ensure the 28 29 accessibility and effectiveness of these forums; and 30 31 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that these legislative engagement 32 forums should include educational materials, workshops, and mentorship opportunities that enable Native Hawaiians to 33 34 effectively navigate the legislative process; and 35 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Office of Hawaiian Affairs 36 is urged to provide an annual report to the Legislature 37 summarizing the activities, participation, and impact of these 38 39 forums, as well as recommendations for further improvement; and 40 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Office of Hawaiian Affairs 41 is requested to provide an annual report to the Legislature 42



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concerning its activities, as it pertains to educational and 1 2 communal engagement opportunities regarding legislative 3 processes; and 4 5 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Office of Hawaiian Affairs is urged to consider establishing an advisory group composed of 6 Native Hawaiian leaders, educators, and policy experts to guide 7 and enhance the effectiveness of these efforts; and 8 9 10 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Chairperson of the 11 12 Board of Trustees of the Office of Hawaiian Affairs and Chief Executive Officer of the Office of Hawaiian Affairs. 13
