WHEREAS, the University of Hawaii serves as the State's 1 foremost provider of public higher education and workforce 2 3 development; and 4 5 WHEREAS, the Office of the Vice President for Academic Strategy of the University of Hawaii is responsible for 6 7 overseeing system-wide policies, programs, and initiatives that shape the institution's academic quality, career pathways, 8 9 workforce pipelines, and performance metrics; and 10 11 WHEREAS, the University of Hawaii has established performance metrics for its academic programs, and regular 12 13 assessment of the metrics is necessary to enhance transparency 14 and accountability; and 15 WHEREAS, the Legislature recognizes the importance of 16 workforce pipeline development from pre-school through 17 post-secondary education, specifically the role of Hawaii P-20 18 Partnerships for Education in building seamless pathways for 19 20 students; and 21 WHEREAS, it is vital to evaluate the University of Hawaii's 22 plan to develop career pathways to ensure alignment with the 23 State's industry needs and to facilitate students' transition to 24 gainful employment; and 25 26 27 WHEREAS, a management and performance audit of the Office of the Vice President for Academic Strategy of the University of 28 Hawaii would provide valuable insights to the efficiency, 29 effectiveness, and impact of programs and initiatives under its 30 scope, enabling evidence-based improvements and strategic 31 32 decision-making; now, therefore, 33
