SENATE RESOLUTION

SUPPORTING AND ENCOURAGING A BROADER RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN THE STATE AND THE KINGDOM OF NORWAY.

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the State to 1 2 cultivate meaningful relationships with countries and governments to collaborate on solutions to shared challenges; 3 4 and 5 WHEREAS, the State and the Kingdom of Norway share common 6 challenges as geographically distinct regions with unique 7 environmental, economic, and social concerns; and 8 9 WHEREAS, both the State and Norway are deeply reliant on 10 11 their marine environments, with significant portions of their 12 economies and cultures tied to fisheries, aquaculture, and ocean conservation; and 13 14 WHEREAS, Norway has developed one of the world's most 15 sustainable and technologically advanced fishing and aquaculture 16 industries, offering valuable insights that could benefit 17 Hawaii's ongoing efforts to enhance its local seafood production 18 19 and marine resource management; and 20 21 WHEREAS, both the State and Norway are at the forefront of renewable energy development, with Hawaii committed to achieving 22 one hundred percent renewable energy by 2045 and Norway being a 23 global leader in hydropower, offshore wind energy, and electric 24 transportation; and 25 26 WHEREAS, the State could benefit from Norway's expertise in 27 electric mobility, sustainable urban planning, and green energy 28 infrastructure, particularly in relation to integrating clean 29 energy into island-based economies; and 30 31 WHEREAS, the State could further benefit from Norway's 32 approach to prisons and criminal justice, as a subject of 33 conversation and collaboration; and 34

1 2 WHEREAS, tourism is a major economic driver for both Hawaii and Norway, and the two regions can exchange best practices in 3 sustainable tourism management to balance economic growth with 4 5 environmental preservation; and 6 7 WHEREAS, Norway has a strong tradition of Arctic and marine research that aligns with the State's research institutions' 8 9 focus on oceanography, climate change, and marine biodiversity, creating opportunities for academic and scientific 10 11 collaboration; and 12 13 WHEREAS, Norway has established a robust social safety net 14 that provides comprehensive healthcare, education, and social welfare programs, serving as a model for policies that support 15 16 quality of life and economic stability; and 17 18 WHEREAS, fostering a broader relationship between Hawaii 19 and Norway would enhance cross-cultural understanding, 20 facilitate economic and academic partnerships, and promote joint initiatives in renewable energy, ocean conservation, and 21 22 sustainable development; now, therefore, 23 24 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Thirty-third Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2025, 25 that this body supports and encourages a broader relationship 26 27 between the State and the Kingdom of Norway; and 28 29 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this 30 Resolution be transmitted to the Governor and Director of Business, Economic Development, and Tourism. 31
