RE: Strong Support for SB 2352 Relating to Safe Haven Law

Aloha and thank you for the opportunity to provide our testimony. Hawaii Family Forum is a non-profit, pro-family education organization committed to preserving and strengthening families in Hawaii, representing a network of various Christian Churches and denominations.

Back in 2007, we submitted testimony in strong support of then bill HB 1830 because we believed that passage of the law would "very well save the lives of precious, helpless, defenseless newborns" by allowing birthmothers a 'safe haven' opportunity to lovingly ensure the safety and well-being of their babies.

Supporters of the law understand that safe-haven laws are designed to protect babies from harm or neglect when they are born to a young woman, who for many different reasons, may not be able to take on the responsibilities of parenthood. While there are those who may have a negative reaction to a mother who doesn't feel ready for motherhood, we believe that the end goal is simple: to give an unwanted newborn the best possible chance to survive and thrive.

In our 2007 testimony, we asked for an amendment providing funding for ongoing education about the bill because initial evaluation of several state laws (at that time) had led some observers to note the importance of providing funding for public awareness. We appreciate that SB2352 appropriates necessary funding to the Department of Health to achieve the goal of engaging a public awareness campaign on the safe haven law here in Hawaii.
