In consideration of HOUSE BILL 95 RELATING TO SPECIAL LICENSE PLATES FOR NATURAL RESOURCES

House Bill 95 proposes to authorize the issuance of special license plates for recognition and protection of the State's natural resources. The Department of Land and Natural Resources (Department) SUPPORTS this measure provided that its passage does not replace or adversely impact priorities indicated in the Executive Biennium Budget request.

The Department recognizes the importance of Hawaii's unique natural and cultural resources to sustaining life in the islands, and that management of these resources is substantially underfunded, especially when considering the challenges we face with climate change and the current economic crisis. Further, as demonstrated over this past year, Hawaii's natural resources are vital to maintaining the health and well-being of our residents.

Similar fundraising license plates are utilized across the country, to great success, in states such as Iowa, Wisconsin, Minnesota, Georgia, and California, to name a few. Even here in Hawaii, National Parks are utilizing this creative and effective fundraising tool.

The Department supports this measure as it will provide the opportunity for dedicated funding to support the Department's Division of Conservation and Resources Enforcement. As shown in other localities, people are more willing to support initiatives if they know their contributions will be put directly into the management of the resources. The Conservation and Resources Enforcement Special Fund is the appropriate fund to support the purposes of this bill.
