REQUESTING THE HAWAII SISTER-STATE COMMITTEE TO EVALUATE AND DEVELOP RECOMMENDATIONS FOR THE INITIATION OF A SISTER-STATE RELATIONSHIP WITH THE CITY OF AUCKLAND, NEW ZEALAND.

Chair Gates, Vice Chair Tam, and members of the Committee.

The Department of Business, Economic Development and Tourism (DBEDT) offers the following comments to HCR 110/HR 106 that requests the Hawaii Sister-State Committee to evaluate and develop recommendations for the initiation of a sister-state relationship with the City of Auckland, New Zealand.

HRS [§229-1] defines a sister state or province relationship to mean a relationship between the State of Hawaii and the state or province or similar governmental or political subdivision of a foreign nation.

This definition precludes Hawaii from entering into a sister "state" relationship with Auckland, which is a city.

While Auckland, New Zealand has sister city relationships with several cities worldwide, it does not have one with a state. There currently exists no sister state relationship between Auckland and another U.S. state.
