I think it would be a wonderful gesture on our part as a Legislature. Thank you, Mr. Speaker."

Earlier this year, President Bush signed into law a bill that creates a \$38 million matching grant program to help communities preserve the sites where Japanese-Americans and Japanese nationals were incarcerated, specifically noting the Honouliuli Internment Camp on Oʻahu. The Hawaiʻi internment camps have important stories to tell and valuable lessons to teach us about US history. These lessons are best taught in the outdoor arena of the original site, where they can bring the camp back to life."
