"It's going to bring in a lot of money from the mainland. Basically, it's the \$20 million that this is going to get, is going to be mainland contractors. So there's obviously a State benefit, but there's also that very small high tech industry that we're going to be pushing aside, and because of that I have some reservations.

"This is basically a tax increase for our high tech industry, which heretofore we've been giving tax credits, etc. So I hope it's not getting even with them, but giving them a chance to grow in the future. Thank you."
