

## FORTY-SEVENTH DAY

Thursday, April 11, 2013

The House of Representatives of the Twenty-Seventh Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2013, convened at 12:10 o'clock p.m., with Vice Speaker Mizuno presiding.
