### KA HUA 'ŌLELO O KA LĀ HAWAIIAN WORD FOR THE DAY

At this time, the Chair stated:

"Before going into the Hawaiian Word for the Day, Members, I just want to remind you that in 2013 we passed Senate Bill 409, Senate Draft 1, which was signed into law as Act 28, designating February as '*Olelo Hawaii* Month. To participate in this opportunity to promote and support Hawaiian language awareness, the House will be having a Hawaiian Word for the Day for the entire month of February."

Representative Ing presented *Ka Hua 'Õlelo o Ka Lā*, the Hawaiian Word for the Day, as follows:

"Thank you, Mr. Speaker. 'O Pepeluali 'o kēia mahina, ka mahina 'Ōlelo Hawai'i. 'O ka onipa'a ka hua 'ōlelo o kēia lā. It's been a tradition for the House of Representatives to have a Hawaiian Word for the Day, so I'm honored to continue on this tradition as the Chair of Hawaiian Affairs. This month we're going to try to open it up to the rest of the Members, if they have a word or they would like to lead one of the days, then we'll be happy to introduce you and allow you to do so.

"Today's Hawaiian Word for the Day is *onipa'a*. *Onipa'a* means fixed, immovable, motionless, steadfast, firm, resolute and determined. This was the motto of Kamehameha V and our Queen Liliuokalani, and it was exemplified day by day by our Representative from East Maui, Representative Carroll. Mele was active with the Royal Order of Kamehameha, which was founded by Kamehameha V. Every vote she made, she always thought about her community, and her conscience would stand firm, so I think this word is very proper.

"'Oi 'oi o Maui Hikina. East Maui forges ahead. Those of East Maui are said to be very active and able to withstand anything, and I think that's the legacy that will be left in the absence of Representative Carroll. Mahalo."
