SEVENTH DAY

Monday, February 1, 2016

The House of Representatives of the Twenty-Eighth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2016, convened at 12:04 o'clock p.m., with Speaker Souki presiding.

The invocation was delivered by Representative Richard P. Creagan, after which the Roll was called showing all Members present with the exception of Representatives Ichiyama and Oshiro, who were excused.

By unanimous consent, reading and approval of the Journal of the House of Representatives of the Sixth Day was deferred.

KA HUA 'ŌLELO O KA LĀ HAWAIIAN WORD FOR THE DAY

At this time, the Chair stated:

"In 2013, we passed Senate Bill 409, Senate Draft 1, which was signed into law as Act 28, designating February as 'Ölelo Hawaii Month. To participate in this opportunity to promote and support Hawaiian language awareness, the House will be having a Hawaiian word for the day for the entire month of February."

Representative Ing presented $Ka\ Hua\ 'ar{O}lelo\ o\ Ka\ Lar{a}$, the Hawaiian Word for the Day, as follows:

"Following the tradition of last year where we started, we're handing off the Hawaiian word of the day for every session day in February, so if you are not on the list and you are interested in participating, just contact my Office Manager, Aunty Poni Daines.

"The Hawaiian word of the day today is a Hawaiian value. It's a very overlooked one to me, but it's my personal favorite. We hear a lot about *aloha, mana'o, pono, malama*, but this is 'imi 'ike, to seek knowledge, or a seeker of knowledge. So, e 'imi 'ike kākou, may we all be seekers of knowledge."
