#### ORDER OF THE DAY

## SUSPENSION OF RULES

At this time, the Chair stated:

"Members, please note that per Committee Referral Sheet Number 47, Senate Concurrent Resolution 157, Senate Draft 1, has been re-referred solely to the Committee on Health. The Committees on Education and Higher Education waived the referral to this measure, and therefore it is appropriate for the House to consider action for adoption on this measure.

"We're going to be going through a series of three motions. First motion, motion to suspend. Second motion, motion to reconsider. Third motion, to adopt, would be where we would have floor debate."

On motion by Representative Saiki, seconded by Representative Evans and carried, the rules were suspended to reconsider action previously taken on S.C.R. No. 157, SD 1. (Representatives DeCoite, Har, Ichiyama, Ing, Ito, Souki, Takumi and Tokioka were excused)

# RECONSIDERATION OF ACTION TAKEN

On motion by Representative Saiki, seconded by Representative Evans and carried, the House reconsidered its action previously taken pursuant to the recommendation contained in Standing Committee Report No. 1790, recommending referral to the Committees on Education and Higher Education. (Representatives DeCoite, Har, Ichiyama, Ing, Ito, Souki, Takumi and Tokioka were excused.)

## UNFINISHED BUSINESS

## S.C.R. No. 157, SD 1:

Representative Saiki moved that S.C.R. No. 157, SD 1 be adopted, seconded by Representative Evans.

Representative Tupola rose to speak in opposition to the measure, stating:

"Thank you, Mr. Speaker. Please register a no vote. I just wanted to share additional information. I had already kind of commented what some of my reservations are on this measure. It's suggesting that we give out information, that we make sure to advocate or let parents know about vaccines. My concern is that the back half needs to be done first, meaning the research and the data. So making sure that what we're passing out is accurate

"Since September 1, 2015, there's been 47 incidents reported from meningococcal vaccinations. Two of them resulted in deaths and 45 of them were serious injuries. And so I think when we talked with the Department of Health that was my concern, is if we pursue this and we start passing out information, how much have we done research on making sure that we've noted and, especially here in Hawaii, I guess taking into consideration what adverse events have happened since people have taken the vaccines.

"So the CDC does encourage for 11 and 12-year-olds to take the HPV as well as the meningococcal vaccination. But what hasn't been done is the study of both of these vaccinations being done at the same time.

"So that's my concern, is that we do this back half of data and fact-finding before we pass out any information to the public or encourage parents on things that we may or may not have all the accurate data. Thank you, Mr. Speaker."

Representative Ward rose to speak in support of the measure with reservations, stating:

"Mr. Speaker, with reservations. The bottom line, it's not ready for prime time yet until they do more homework. Thank you."

The motion was put to vote by the Chair and carried, S.C.R. Representative McKelvey's written remarks are as follows:

"I rise in strong support of the resolution, Mr. Speaker. Mr. Speaker, while most resolutions only convey the wishes of the Legislature in areas to which we do not have legislative control, this resolution is quite substantive. This resolution would allow for the transfer of land in Kahului that could then be used to create immediate affordable housing in the area.

"Mr. Speaker, by simply adopting this resolution we will be able to accelerate the building of much needed units in an area that is close to schools, the University of Hawaii, and Queen Ka'ahumanu Center, plus many other businesses in the area.

"This also, Mr. Speaker, creates a solid precedence of county and state support in creating affordable housing that can be tailor-made towards our working families within the area, as there is no federal monies involved which is what has created outside demand for our affordable housing units and restricted our ability to be able to channel such projects to our residents who so desperately need it.

"Mr. Speaker, I hope this resolution, through its adoption, will help to spur more of these partnerships and allow for more types of transfers and collaborations that will accelerate the building of much needed affordable housing both in Maui and elsewhere in the State of Hawaii."
