

## FIFTY-EIGHTH DAY

Friday, April 28, 2017

The House of Representatives of the Twenty-Ninth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2017, convened at 6:36 o'clock p.m., with Speaker Souki presiding.

The invocation was delivered by Pastor Michael Brownfield of the Honolulu Japanese Seventh-Day Adventist Church, after which the Roll was called showing all Members present with the exception of Representatives Har, Ing, Quinlan and Thielen, who were excused.

By unanimous consent, reading and approval of the Journal of the House of Representatives of the Fifty-Seventh Day was deferred.
