Representative Ward: "Thank you, Mr. Speaker. We know we're not convening on Monday because it's Martin Luther King Day. And Mr. Speaker, I wanted to add a couple of demographics, data points for this great man and the great time that we're going to have a day off. Mr. Speaker, he got his PhD in 1955, and that was from the Boston theological university. But his career really started after a brief pastorate in Montgomery when he started the bus boycott. It was 382 days that the blacks of Montgomery, Alabama boycotted because of the segregation on busses.

"In the process of his life, he wrote five books and articles inspiring the letter from Birmingham. But Mr. Speaker, what we most remember is the 'I Have a Dream' speech that was in 1963 after a march of 250,000 people in Washington D.C. One of the quotes that's indelibly in our minds, in our memories, is, I have a dream that my four children will one day live in the nation where they will not be judged by the color of their skin, but the content of their character. That quote will live in everyone's heart who loves freedom. But then he was arrested, and it was 20 times that he was put in jail. He had five honorary degrees, was Time's Man of the Year, and in 1968 won the Nobel Peace Prize.

"Mr. Speaker, this is a man who needs to be acknowledged, so as we take the day off on Monday, we can remember that we stand on the shoulders of such great men in this nation, and his name is Martin Luther King. Thank you."
