

EIGHTEENTH DAY

Wednesday, February 13, 2019

The House of Representatives of the Thirtieth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2019, convened at 12:02 o'clock p.m., with Speaker Saiki presiding.

The invocation was delivered by Pastor Patrick McFall of New Hope Hawaii Kai, after which the Roll was called showing all members present with the exception of Representatives Cabanilla Arakawa, Cachola, Holt, Nakamura, Todd, Woodson and Yamane, who were excused.

By unanimous consent, reading and approval of the Journal of the House of Representatives of the Seventeenth Day was deferred.

INTRODUCTION OF RESOLUTIONS
