The invocation was delivered by Reverend Glenn Nochi of Bodaiji Mission, after which the Roll was called showing all members present with the exception of Representatives Aquino and Nakamura, who were excused.

On motion by Representative Morikawa, seconded by Representative Matsumoto and carried, reading of the Journal was dispensed with and the Journals of the Sixth, Seventh, Eighth, Ninth and Tenth Days were approved. (Representatives Aquino, Hashem and Nakamura were excused.)

Representative Thielen rose to speak in opposition to the measure, stating:

"Thank you. Mr. Speaker, I'd like to cast a no vote on HB 362 and believe that the information should be made public in the amount in which it is paid. Thank you."

Representative Okimoto rose and asked that the Clerk record an aye vote with reservations for her, and the Chair "so ordered."

Representative Ward rose to speak in opposition to the measure, stating:

"Mr. Speaker, no vote with a brief comment, please. Mr. Speaker, I would vote for this if there would be parity between the Minority Research Office and the Majority Research Office. However, looking at the data where it is now on the present system, we have a 35% deficit in terms of parity. This is going to cover that up, it's not going to breed transparency, and I'm afraid that we'll never reach parity if we have these \$15,000 increments of way of describing salary.

"So, the intent is good, to open it and give it brackets like we do with the ethics disclosure, *et cetera*. But in terms of parity, I think our workers and our researchers deserve a transparent raise, but this may cloud it, cover it, and otherwise not be able to disclose that difference. For those reasons, Mr. Speaker, a no. Thank you."

Representative Matsumoto rose and asked that the Clerk record an aye vote with reservations for her, and the Chair "so ordered."

Representative Matsumoto then rose and asked that the Clerk record a no vote for her, and the Chair "so ordered."

The motion was put to vote by the Chair and carried, and the report of the Committee was adopted and H.B. "64% of the Great Pacific Garbage Patch is comprised of materials from fishing nets, ropes and lines.

"Boyan Slat, 'Evidence that the Great Pacific Garbage Patch is rapidly accumulating plastic,' *Scientific Reports*, March 22, 2018.

"The Ocean Cleanup - Boyan Slat raised \$32 million to clean the Great Pacific Garbage Patch.

"Hard plastics, sheets and films (36.02%)

"Fishing nets, ropes and lines (63.76%)

"Plastic pellets (0.19%)

"Foam (0.03%)

"Non-Asia and non-fishing plastic/foam materials in the Great Pacific Garbage Patch is 2.5%.

"Non-fishing material @ 36.24% x plastic pollution from 10 rivers @ 93% = 2.5%.

"Non-Asia and non-fishing foam material in the Great Pacific Garbage Patch is 0.0021%.

"Foam material in the Great Pacific Garbage Patch @ 0.03% x plastic pollution from 10 rivers @ 93% = 0.0021%.

"Plastic straw statistics came from a 9-year-old boy in 2011.

"Niraj Chokshi, 'How a 9-Year-Old Boy's Statistic Shaped a Debate on Straws,' *New York Times*, July 19, 2018."
