Representative Ward rose to speak in opposition to the measure, stating:

"Mr. Speaker, no vote with a brief comment, please. Mr. Speaker, this bill proposes to tax, surcharge, or otherwise make the cost of electrical vehicle purchase and operation more expensive. It's a tax increase, but that's not the issue. The issue is, we are trying to be fossil fuel free, which means electric cars really fit the bill for what this body stands for and what the State is now leading the nation in doing.

"However, if you look at the numbers, I think we're premature in what this bill proposes. We had 1% of the vehicles on the roads of the State of Hawaii, 1%, Mr. Speaker. The point is, you don't develop a momentum or a tipping point with 1%. Inevitably, we have to make them pay their fair share because they do use the roads, but I think it's premature now to be taxing electrical vehicles, therefore possibly shutting down the purchase and the operation of electrical vehicles.

"My point is, it's a good bill, it's not timely, and if we really are going to be an electric, fossil free transportation network in Hawaii, this bill needs to be postponed for about at least two or three more years before the time is ready. Thank you, Mr. Speaker."
