

TWENTY-EIGHTH DAY

Monday, March 9, 2020

The House of Representatives of the Thirtieth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2020, convened at 12:03 p.m., with Vice Speaker Nakashima presiding.

The invocation was delivered by Dr. Jerald Garcia of the Hawaii Institute of Pain, after which the Roll was called showing all members present with the exception of Representatives Gates, McKelvey, and Thielen, who were excused.

By unanimous consent, reading and approval of the Journal of the House of Representatives of the Twenty-Seventh Day was deferred.

GOVERNOR'S MESSAGES

INTRODUCTION OF RESOLUTIONS (FLOOR PRESENTATIONS)

The following resolution (H.R. No. 182) was announced by the Clerk and the following action taken:

H.R. No. 182, entitled: "HOUSE RESOLUTION CONGRATULATING THE KAUA'I COUNTY PLANNING DEPARTMENT FOR THEIR PLAN, KAUA'I KAKOU: KAUA'I COUNTY GENERAL PLAN," was jointly offered by Representatives Nakamura, Lowen, Morikawa, Tarnas, and Tokioka.

Representative Nakamura moved that H.R. No. 182 be adopted, seconded by Representative Tarnas.

Representative Nakamura congratulated the Kauai Planning Department on winning the American Planning Association's 2019 Daniel Burnham Award for a Comprehensive Plan for their Kaua'i Kākou: Kaua'i County General Plan, which addresses critical issues, guides the county's growth, and creates a system for action, evaluation, and accountability in a transparent and robust planning effort that involved residents at every phase of the planning process, and introduced honorees from the Kauai Planning Department who were seated on the Floor of the House:

 Marisa Valenciano, Long Range Planner.

Representative Tarnas, as a planning consultant who participated in many community meetings for the plan, commended the genuine commitment to professional excellence and community engagement demonstrated by the

Kauai Planning Department, and congratulated them on the national recognition.

Representative Morikawa commended the planning department for listening to the community's suggestions and concerns and incorporating them into the plan, and thanked them for all they do to make Kauai a better place.

The motion was put to vote by the Chair and carried, and H.R. No. 182 was adopted, with Representatives Gates, Ichiyama, Matsumoto, McKelvey, and Thielen being excused.
