Wednesday, March 11, 2020

The House of Representatives of the Thirtieth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2020, convened at 12:02 p.m., with Speaker Saiki presiding.

The invocation was delivered by Representative Romy M. Cachola, after which the Roll was called showing all members present with the exception of Representatives Matsumoto and Yamane, who were excused.

By unanimous consent, reading and approval of the Journal of the House of Representatives of the Twenty-Ninth Day was deferred.

INTRODUCTION OF RESOLUTIONS

The following resolution (H.R. No. 185) was announced by the Clerk and the following action taken:

H.R. No. 185, entitled: "HOUSE RESOLUTION HONORING ROBERT LOPAKA KAPANUI FOR HIS DEDICATION AND PASSION TO PERPETUATING HAWAII'S RICH CULTURAL LEGACY AND HISTORY THROUGH THE ART OF STORYTELLING," was offered by Representative B. Kobayashi.

Representative B. Kobayashi moved that H.R. No. 185 be adopted, seconded by Representative Nishimoto.

Representative B. Kobayashi recognized the honoree as a master storyteller that uses storytelling as a tool for entertainment, teaching, and to preserve culture and history.

Representative Nishimoto recognized Robert Lopaka Kapanui as a Native Hawaiian storyteller, writer, actor, *kumu hula*, and cultural practitioner known as "The Ghost Guy" who has shared the ghost stories, tales, legends, and history of Hawaii with thousands of people over the years; thanked him and his wife Tanya for preserving the knowledge, history, and legends of Hawaii; and introduced honorees who were seated on the Floor of the House:

Robert Lopaka Kapanui, Owner, Mysteries of Hawaii; and
Tanya Kapanui, his wife and business partner.

The motion was put to vote by the Chair and carried, and H.R. No. 185 was adopted, with Representatives Ichiyama, Lowen, and Matsumoto being excused.

At this time, the Chair stated:

"Members, given our public health concerns, in lieu of individual greetings, could the members please give a round of applause to our honorees this morning."

At 12:16 p.m., the Chair declared a recess subject to the call of the Chair.
