Tuesday, April 20, 2021

The House of Representatives of the Thirty-First Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2021, convened at 11:34 a.m., with Vice Speaker Mizuno presiding.

The invocation was delivered by Representative Ryan I. Yamane, after which the Roll was called showing all members present, with Representative Har participating remotely via videoconference, and with the exception of Representative McDermott, who was excused.
