Tuesday, February 1, 2022

The House of Representatives of the Thirty-First Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2022, convened at noon, with Speaker Saiki presiding.

The invocation was delivered by Representative Sonny Ganaden, after which the Roll was called showing all members present, with Representatives Gates, Har, D. Kobayashi, LoPresti, Matayoshi, Perruso, and Wildberger participating remotely via videoconference.
