

NINETEENTH DAY

Wednesday, February 15, 2023

The House of Representatives of the Thirty-Second Legislature of the State of Hawai'i, Regular Session of 2023, convened at 12:03 p.m., with Vice Speaker Ilagan presiding.

The invocation was delivered by Representative Jeanne Kapela, after which the Roll was called showing all members present with the exception of Representative Quinlan, who was excused.

By unanimous consent, reading and approval of the Journal of the House of Representatives of the Eighteenth Day was deferred.

"Mr. Speaker, this creates high paying jobs. It's pollution free, so to speak, in that it's not an industrial smokestack industry. And it's something, I would hope, would start a trend, and I want to thank the author for introducing this, and I hope this sails through. And I hope it's a beginning for future diversification, to some have said, we can be the sports center of the Pacific, if we get a stadium eventually, if this body decides what to do with that. We can be the diplomatic Geneva of the Pacific, diplomacy, we have the East-West Center and the other in Waikiki. We could also be space tourism.

"The point is, Mr. Speaker, we've got to think outside of the box because, and here's the bottom line, we have half of our population is ALICE families, asset limited income challenged, and they're working. We are the stewards, if you will, of this economy. And when we have half of our population, we don't have an economy this size. And this helps expand that economy, it helps good paying jobs, and it's probably one of the best bills this session, if it goes all the way through. For those reasons, I hope everybody votes with exemplary enthusiasm. Thank you."
