Representative Garcia rose to speak in opposition to the measure, stating:

"In opposition. Thank you, Mr. Speaker. The bill would establish a *ho'okaulike* at the Richardson School of Law. My only concern for this, and my reason for voting no, is that during testimony in the committee, the dean of the law school said that this is meant to implement aspects of critical race theory and she said that she herself is a critical race theorist. So, for those reasons, a no vote."

Representative Pierick rose and asked that the Clerk record a no vote for him, and the Chair "so ordered."

Representative Souza rose to speak in support of the measure, stating:

"In strong support, Mr. Speaker. We also had the pleasure of hearing from the dean of the law school in the Judiciary Committee. And although she is

a critical race theorist, I do not believe that this program would fully implement those theories. And generally, the program is a positive thing for the law school and to bring people together. Thank you."

Representative Perruso rose to speak in support of the measure, stating:

"In strong support. I am concerned that the conversation around this measure would have anything to do with the academic credentials and background of the dean of the law school. This program in particular is meant to be one that addresses criminal justice reform, and it is an interdisciplinary approach that includes the school of public health, the law school, and the school of Hawaiian knowledge. So, I hope that the body can support this measure. I think that we can have conversations about critical race theory and its importance at another time, but it's not really relevant in this context. *Mahalo*."

Representative Ward rose and asked that the Clerk record an aye vote with reservations for him, and the Chair "so ordered."

Representative Matayoshi, for the Committee on Labor & Government Operations, presented a report (Stand. Com. Rep. No. 573) recommending that H.B. No. 1202, as amended in HD 1, pass Second Reading and be referred to the Committee on Finance.

Representative Nakamura moved that the report of the Committee be adopted, and that H.B. No. 1202, HD 1 pass Second Reading and be referred to the Committee on Finance, seconded by Representative Morikawa.

Representative Garcia rose to speak in support of the measure with reservations, stating:

"With reservations, brief comment. The original bill, I fully support. But the HD 1, it removes the exemption for small businesses and makes it a bit tougher for them to do this. So, with reservations."

Representative Kapela rose to speak in support of the measure, stating:

"Thank you, Mr. Speaker. In strong support with a brief comment. I would like to thank the chair of the Committee on Labor & Government Operations for passing a strong sick leave bill through our committee. Currently, approximately 180,000 workers in Hawai'i lack access to sick leave, most of whom work in the service industry in jobs that frequently engage the public, like food servers and sales associates.

"Low-income workers and women are significantly less likely to have paid sick leave than other members of our workforce. Only one in five low-income workers has access to paid sick leave. Studies have shown that access to sick leave actually reduces the cost for businesses, especially small businesses, because it increases employee retention.

"We just went through the pandemic, whose effects we are still feeling today. We know that people were and still are going to work with COVID-19 because they cannot afford to sacrifice their financial security in order to get better. Paid sick leave is essential to preserving personal and public health, giving employees time to recover from illness and prevent the spread of contagions in our communities.

"I would also like to add that I am very grateful for the HD 1 of this bill that cuts out the exemption for small businesses. Because if we were to use that exemption, 91% of all businesses in Hawai'i are small businesses with less than 50 employees, which means that all of those workers would not have access to this very, very important opportunity to get better. Thank you."

The motion was put to vote by the Chair and carried, and the report of the Committee was adopted and H.B. No. 1202, HD 1, entitled: "A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO PAID SICK LEAVE," passed Second Reading and was referred to the Committee on Finance, with Representative Garcia voting aye with reservations, and with Representative Todd being excused.
