### Tuesday, March 21, 2023

"With reservations. No, actually, full support. This actually is a good bill, Mr. Speaker. I've changed my mind, I am in support. You can see I've got mixed emotions because this is good because so many families can't afford the meal. This bill says everybody gets a free lunch, which is good. But it's an indictment on our economy, Mr. Speaker. And that's what grieves me.

"Even without this bill, the majority of students in our public schools qualify for a free lunch. Parents don't earn enough money because of the small size of our economy to feed their kids. I've said many times it's comparable to somebody who's got eight kids, three can be fed fully, two are on rations, the other three are on some government subsidy.

"I hold us responsible because we are supposed to be, quote, diversifying the economy, getting higher paying jobs. I don't see too much legislation to that effect, Mr. Speaker.

"For those reasons, this is a good bill, but it's an indictment that we're not diversifying our economy. We're not getting enough money into our families to be able to afford school lunches. For those reasons, Mr. Speaker, I'm for it, but with reservations, but I'm voting fully on top of it. But it grieves me to see this. As we know, there are so many ALICE families that are in this predicament, and likely they are mostly right here. And one last statistic, 63% of the Hawaiian community are ALICE families. And that's something that we have to focus on in the future. Thank you."

Representative Kapela rose to speak in support of the measure, stating:

"Thank you, Mr. Speaker. In strong support. I recently got to visit students at Naalehu Elementary School. And from kindergarten all the way through fifth grade, their number one request was that they all were able to have not just school lunches, but larger school lunches as well. I think that hunger shouldn't be a barrier to education. Thank you."
