Tuesday, April 4, 2023

The House of Representatives of the Thirty-Second Legislature of the State of Hawai'i, Regular Session of 2023, convened at 12:04 p.m., with Speaker Saiki presiding.

The invocation was delivered by Representative Adrian K. Tam, after which the Roll was called showing all members present with the exception of Representative Mizuno, who was excused.

By unanimous consent, reading and approval of the Journal of the House of Representatives of the Forty-Third Day was deferred.

"Mr. Speaker, I rise on a point of personal privilege. In my speech on this floor yesterday, I mentioned the words 'cancel culture,' which immediately thereafter or shortly thereafter, they were stricken from the record. My fear, Mr. Speaker, is that we're going down a slippery slope of shredding the First Amendment rights of duly elected representatives.

"I would remind the body that, look, I'm a member of the minority. We are the loyal opposition. We are the check and the balance on this floor. Not everything that we say is going to be agreeable. But, Mr. Speaker, I implore you, please do not strike through a cancel culture the remarks of your minority, which have a right to say what they say on this body, which is in a democracy, a given right through our U.S. Constitution.

"For those reasons, Mr. Speaker, I just thank you, but I think for the sake of democracy, we've got to allow words to be said, disagreement. Because this is the marketplace of ideas. Some ideas are going to work, some are going to rise up, some are going to fall. But we cannot just cancel because we don't agree with them. That is not democracy. Thank you."
