That's why I am strongly in support of this resolution. Thank you, Mr. Speaker."

Representative Alcos rose to speak in support of the measure, stating:

"In strong support. Mr. Speaker, this issue been going on for decades already in my community, the noise pollution. I live about a mile and a half away. It starts from 7:00 a.m. in the morning, the noise. And they fire 7,000 rounds or more a day out in that area. The community don't want the noise. I don't think anybody want a rifle range in their community. I think it's long overdue. We do care about the support for our military, but we don't believe that it should be next to a community park, next to the next Hawaiian homes that they're going to build, next to our community, next to our elementary school, and I take my grandkids playing there. And with the lead poisoning that going on into our ocean, I believe that we could find a better location for this firing range. Thank you."

Representative Pierick rose and asked that the Clerk record an aye vote with reservations for him, and the Chair "so ordered."

The motion was put to vote by the Chair and carried, and the report of the Committee was adopted and H.R. No. 104, HD 1, entitled: "HOUSE RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE RELOCATION OF ALL LIVE FIRE TRAINING AND AVIATION ACTIVITIES AWAY FROM THE PU'ULOA RANGE TRAINING FACILITY," was adopted, with Representative Pierick voting aye with reservations, and with Representatives Amato, Ganaden, Hussey-Burdick, and Kong being excused.
