TWENTY-NINTH DAY

Monday, March 11, 2024

The House of Representatives of the Thirty-Second Legislature of the State of Hawai'i, Regular Session of 2024, convened at noon, with Vice Speaker llagan presiding.

The invocation was delivered by Representative Amy A. Perruso, after which the Roll was called showing all members present with the exception of Representatives Amato, Ichiyama, Lamosao, and Matayoshi, who were excused.

By unanimous consent, reading and approval of the Journal of the House of Representatives of the Twenty-Eighth Day was deferred.
