SUBJECT: Conference Procedures - Announcement of Final

Conference Drafts

Effectively immediately, when a conference committee is set to vote upon a bill in conference committee, the lead House chair is required to clearly summarize the purpose and content of the bill before the vote is taken. This applies even where the agreement only consists of an amended effective date (in other words, it is not sufficient to merely explain, for example, that "the conferees agree to the Senate amendments" or "the conferees have agreed to change the effective date to January 1, 2025"). The summary is not meant to be exhaustive; rather, it must only include a general explanation of the purpose and context of the bill and the amendments that have been agreed upon.

This disclosure requirement applies to House lead chairs and applies to both House and Senate bills. If the Senate lead chair does not summarize the content of an agreed-upon Senate bill prior to the vote, then the House lead chair must do so. This requirement also applies where the House conferees meet without the Senate in order to agree to a draft.

The purpose of this new procedure is to reasonably inform the conference committee conferees and the general public of the content of the measure that is being voted upon. An explanation is particularly helpful where no written proposed conference draft has been made available and conferees are requested to vote upon provisions that are only verbally announced. In those situations, an explanation will also assist staff who are drafting the final version of the conference draft.

Please note that because amendments to the Executive operating budget will be announced on a day-by-day basis, the Finance Chair is not required to restate amendments to the budget bill prior to the conference committee vote. Similarly, this requirement does not apply if written lists of CIP and GIA grantees are made available to the House conferees prior to the vote.
