THIRTY-FIRST DAY

Friday, March 20, 2026

The House of Representatives of the Thirty-Third Legislature of the State of Hawai'i, Regular Session of 2026, convened at 12:17 p.m., with Speaker Nakamura presiding.

The Roll was called showing all members present with the exception of Representative Quinlan.
