### THIRTY-FIRST DAY

Thursday, February 27, 1975

The Senate of the Eighth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 1975, convened at 11:30 o'clock a.m., with the President in the Chair.

The Divine Blessing was invoked by Major Glenn Austin of the Salvation Army, after which the Roll was called showing all Senators present with the exception of Senator Rohlfing who was excused.

The President announced that he had read and approved the Journal of the Thirtieth Day.
