HOUSE COMMUNICATION

A communication from the House (Hse. Com. No. 2) transmitting House Concurrent Resolution No. 2 which was adopted by the House of Representatives on January 22, 1976, was read by the Clerk and was placed on file.

On motion by Senator Taira, seconded by Senator Anderson and carried, H.C.R. No. 2, entitled: "HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION HONORING THE LATE NEAL S. BLAISDELL, FORMER MAYOR OF HONOLULU", was adopted.

SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

A concurrent resolution (S.C.R. No. 1),

entitled: "SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION RELATING TO THE BLOOD DONOR PROGRAM OF THE BLOOD BANK OF HAWAII", was jointly offered by Senators Ushijima, Ching, Taira, Yamasaki, Chong, Hulsten, F. Wong, Yim, Kawasaki, Toyofuku, Soares, Hara, Leopold, Henderson, Saiki, Takitani, George, Kuroda, Nishimura, O'Connor, R. Wong, Young, King, Anderson and Yee and was read by the Clerk.

On motion by Senator Ching, seconded by Senator Taira and carried, S.C.R. No. 1 was adopted.

At this time, Senator George introduced to the members of the Senate Mr. and Mrs. Sukefumi Ito from Hiroshima with their daughter Shigeyo and her husband, Bob Ricci.

At 11:37 o'clock a.m., the Senate stood in recess subject to the call of the Chair.

The Senate reconvened at 11:39 o'clock a.m.
