

## NINTH DAY

Monday, February 2, 1976

The Senate of the Eighth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 1976, convened at 11:30 o'clock a.m., with the President in the Chair.

The Divine Blessing was invoked by Canon James Long of the Episcopal Church, after which the Roll was called showing all Senators present, with the exception of Senator F. Wong, who was excused.

The President announced that he had read and approved the Journal of the Eighth Day.

At this time, Senator Yee introduced to the members of the Senate the Narcissus Queen and members of her court as follows: Queen, Coralie Sai Lin Chun; First Princess, Caroline Wang; Third Princess, Sandra Mew; and Fourth Princess, Lisa Chock. Accompanying them was Mr. Anthony Ching, General Chairman of the Narcissus Festival and President-elect of the Chinese Chamber of Commerce. Members of the Court were presented with leis by Senators Anderson, Ching, Taira and Yee. The Queen, Miss Chun, was then escorted to the rostrum where she was presented with a copy of the Senate Resolution congratulating her and the Court. She then addressed the members of the Senate expressing their appreciation for the adoption of the resolution and allowing them to be here today.
